



DBE FY2020-2022 GOAL KENTON COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD

As required by the provisions of 49 CFR Part 26, the Kenton County Airport Board (KCAB), operator of the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport (CVG) located in Boone County, Kentucky, has established an overall goal for the participation of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) in projects for which Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funds may be utilized during Federal Fiscal Years 2020-2022 (October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2022).

KCAB's **overall goal is 10.5%** of which 6.2% is expected through race/gender neutral methods and 4.3% is expected through race/gender conscious methods. KCAB anticipates applying AIP funds to the following projects planned for FY2017-2019: Runway 9/27 Rehabilitation; Taxiway K and J Rehabilitation and Lighting; East Service Road Rehabilitation; Runway 18C-36C Rehabilitation Design; and, Part 150 Noise Study.

For the purpose of consulting with stakeholders to obtain information relevant to the goal-setting process a public meeting will be held at 11:00 a.m. on July 15, 2019 at the CVG Administration Offices, 77 Comair Blvd, Erlanger, Kentucky, 41018.

The proposed goal and rationale are also available for public inspection until July 31, 2019 during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. ET), Monday through Friday, at the CVG Administration Offices, 77 Comair Blvd, Erlanger, Kentucky, 41018.
