TITLE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE KENTON COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD REPEALING AND REPLACING IN ITS ENTIRETY THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE KENTON COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD RELATING TO THE OPERATION AND CONTROL OF THE CINCINNATI/NORTHERN KENTUCKY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

SUMMARY

At the September 20, 2021 regular meeting, the Kenton County Airport Board (KCAB) passed Ordinance 2021-01 which repeals and replaces the Rules and Regulations of the Kenton County Airport Board Relating to the Operation and Control of the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport (the "Rules") in its entirety. The differences between the repealed rules and regulations and enacted Rules include: (a) Reorganization of all rules and regulations chapters, including the creation of new chapters "General Provisions," "Personal Conduct," "Safety," "Security," and "Penalties and Enforcement," and renumbering of chapters; (b) New regulations dealing with Unmanned Aircraft Systems (625.00) to prohibit the unauthorized take-off or landing of unmanned aircraft systems at CVG, Preventing FOD (811.01 and 811.02) to prevent Foreign Object Debris from being created at CVG, and Creation of Hazardous Conditions (812.00) to prohibit hazardous conditions at CVG; (c) changes to Rules including to Request to Inspect Records (204.00 et seq.) that defines KCAB's process to comply with Kentucky Open Records Act (the "Act") requests and changes to the Act made in the Kentucky 2021 regular legislative session, changes to Notification Requirement for Work at the Airport (409.00) to correspond to KCAB's current operational procedures, changes to Rules dealing with operations of Commercial Passenger Vehicles (502.00 et seq.) related to the fees associated with commercial vehicle activity at CVG, changes to rules dealing with vehicle movement in the air operations area (505.05, 505.07, 505.10, 702.15), changes to the application of joint and several liability (904.06) and miscellaneous changes to all regulations related to clarity, uniformity, and references to defined terms; and (d) deletion of outdated regulations including Newsracks (formerly 01.02(7)) and Turnstiles and Coin Operated Doors (formerly 01.06(5)).
